2023-24 Assessment Due Date Reminders!

- Program Assessment Reports, General Education Assessment Reports, and Academic Program Assessment Guidebook updates are due **November 1, 2023**.
- Administrative Support Unit Assessment Reports and Assessment Guidebook updates are due **December 31, 2023**.
- Student Affairs Assessment Reports and Assessment Guidebook updates are due **June 30, 2024**.

This year, the Committee on Instruction will be reviewing general education courses in the **Social and Behavioral Sciences** category. This category includes courses from many of our departments, so please make sure that your department gets your reports in on time.

Also this year, three academic programs are slated for their five-year review: Psychology, Philosophy, and International Studies. The Honors Program will undergo their first intensive review as well. Members of these teams will be shared with the campus community once the rosters have been confirmed. Each of these teams will be looking at ways to assess UT Martin's effectiveness in each of these areas and identifying ways to enhance the work we are doing.

The Center for Teaching and Learning (CTL) is a new initiative for UT Martin. As a partnership between Academic Affairs and Information Technology Services, the CTL is being led by Anderson Starling and Bonnie Daniel.
